The Board of Directors of NHPC Limited has approved the unaudited financial results of the company for the quarter ended June 30. Generation for the quarter was 8549 Million Units (MU), which is higher by 984 MU over the corresponding previous quarter. Revenue from operations for the quarter is `2326 crore which is higher by `142 crore in comparison to the corresponding previous quarter. The company has achieved plant availability factor of 97.13 per cent for the quarter which is higher by 4.83 per cent over the corresponding previous quarter.
