

Docs reconstruct chest wall of B'deshi man:

Doctors at Apollo Hospitals reconstructed the chest wall of 50-year-old Abdullah from Bangladeshi after removing a cancerous tumour from his ribs.

“Doctors in Bangladesh had removed the tumour along with his first and second ribs on the left side in December 2020,” said senior consultant in surgical oncology Dr Ajit Pai. In six months, the tumour returned. A team performed a 14-hour surgery on February 25. The tumour along with part of the ribs and collar bones were removed. The surgeons later reconstructed the chest wall. The patient has recovered well in the post-operative period.
