

Smart City revised bids to be decided on Feb 2

Pimpri Chinchwad: The revised bids for the construction and installation work of several development projects under the Pimpri Chinchwad Smart City will be decided on February 2 and no further extension are to be granted.

The works include laying a 750-km optical fibre network under the city's 'backbone network', installing 270 Wi-Fi spots, 50 Smart City kiosks and 60 variable message display (VMD) systems at various public spots.

The fibre backbone infrastructure would help connect all municipal offices, and government institutions while the VMD systems will provide citizens with real-time updates about city-centric information, traffic status, and emergency services.

The information regarding the scheme was procured through an application under the RTI Act.

The civic body has also decided to install solar power panels at the Yashwantrao Chavan Memorial Hospital (YCMH) along with a water treatment plant in Sector 23 at Nigdi-Pradhikaran.

"A private agency, Clean Max Enviro Energy Solutions Pvt Ltd, has been appointed. At YCMH, the area is 2,000 sq mtr and the power capacity is 147 kWp. At the water treatment plant, the area is 3,800 sq mtr, and the power capacity is 314 kWp," the information note stated.
